WHAT ARE THEY AND WHY THEY ARE DIFFERENT

1. Introduction

- a. Right doctrine needs to be second nature (driving a car, breathing, riding a bike)
- b. Dispensations not periods of time, but messages/revelations outlining God's operation
- c. OHair – pg 131 – no intelligent student of the scriptures believes, or teaches... only one
- d. A gospel is a message, good news... before the good news is the bad news...

2. The problem

- a. Gen 1:28 – 3:15 – sin created a problem that God intended to solve with a promise
- b. God's good news = a promised seed to have dominion over the earth, to bring in righteousness, peace, and joy forever

3. Gospels

- a. Our gospel – 1 Cor 15:1-4
- b. Gospel of Circumcision = seed – bless the world through circumcision: Gal 2:7; Acts 3:24
 - i. Gen 17:5-8; Gen 22:17-18
- c. Gospel of Kingdom = rule/dominion – world blessed through the nation Israel
 - i. 2 Sam 7:16; Dan 2:44; Mark 1:14; Matt 4:17; Matt 10:5-7;
- d. Gospel of Grace = sin/righteousness – Acts 20:24; Eph 3:1-2; Gal 1:6
- e. Gospel of uncircumcision = blessings to all without circumcision – Eph 2:12-15
 - i. Paul preaches to Gentiles _ Rom 11:13; Rom 15:16; Rom 4:9-11
- f. Gospel of peace (reconciliation) = peace with God; restoration
 - i. Eph 6:15; Rom 10:15; 2 Cor 5:17-19; Rom 5:1 (Acts 3:19-21); Rom 5:10 18 19
- g. Everlasting gospel = Fear, glorify, worship God; He is the Judge.
 - i. Rev 14:6; Ps 145:13; Isa 51:6-8; Dan 9:24
- h. Gospel of Christ = the mystery of Christ revealed kept secret since the world began
 - i. Rom 1:16; 2 Cor 4:4; Gal 1:7

4. In the beginning

- a. Gen 1:28 – Multiply (seed); Dominion; Given; Obey (covenant); it was good (peace)
- b. The preaching of Jesus Christ about what he would do to provide salvation to all was kept secret – it was a mystery
