

# 1 Peter 14 - 5:5-14

## 1. 5:5-7 – Submitting one to another

- a. Subject to one another – 1 Peter 3
- b. God gives grace unto the humble – Prov 3:34
- c. “exalt you in due time” – (Paul born out of due time) – Mat 19:28-29
- d. “casting your care upon him” – Mat 6:25, 34, Luke 12:22 → Psalm 34:15
- e. Submit to God, the devil will flee – James 4:6-7

## 2. 5:8-9 – The devil as a roaring lion

- a. Who is the devil? – John 8:44
- b. Serpent? Beast of the field? Gen 3:1 & Rev 12:9
- c. Thou was perfect - Ezekiel 28:11-15
- d. He is a cherub, protector of God – 1:3-14
- e. The Devil is a deceiver – Isaiah 14:12-17
- f. God like a devouring lion when the kingdom comes → Hos 11:10-12
- g. The Lord will roar out of Zion – Joel 3:16
- h. Today, he disguises himself as angel of light – 2 Cor 11:13-15
- i. Paul warns against the gospel from angels – Gal 1:8

## 3. 5:10-11 – The God of all Grace

- a. “called us unto eternal glory” – Eph 1:10
- b. “after ye have suffered a while” – This is not immediate – 1 Pet 1:7, 4:12
- c. The dominions that are Gods – Col 1:16,...but...Heb 2:8
- d. They are waiting for a city – Heb 13:14

## 4. 5:12 – Silvanus...Marcus

- a. Not every same name is the same man (ex. James – Gal 1:19, 2:6,12)
- b. There were people who helped Paul from Peter’s group – Acts 13:1-2
- c. Silvanus was another name for Silas → 2 Cor 1:19 & Acts 18:5
- d. Before Paul, Silas was chief among the Jerusalem brethren - Acts 15:22, 32-34
- e. What did he teach with Paul? → The fall of Israel, salvation has come to Gentiles
- f. There is a smooth transition between the programs through the apostles – Gal 2:9
- g. The contention was with “false brethren” in Peter’s flock – Gal 2:4
- h. “Marcus, my son” is presumed to be John Mark from Jerusalem – Acts 12:12, 25
- i. John Mark bailed from Paul in Pamphylia – Acts 13:13

## 5. 5:12-14

- a. “the true grace of God” – future salvation and reward - 1 Pet 1:2, 10, 13
- b. “elected together with you” – They are part of the little flock – Rom 11:7
- c. “kiss of charity” – their greeting one another with charity - 1 Pet 4:8
