

2 Peter 03 – 2:3-13

1. 2:1-3 – False teachers will lead astray

- a. There “were” and “are” – Peter’s group in history may not be Peter’s doctrine
- b. Peter recognized the existence of false teachings – Acts 15:1
- c. Denying the Lord was a capital offense – Mat 10:33, 1 John 4:3
- d. The Jews at Pentecost denied Jesus – Acts 3:13-14
- e. Redeemed from the OT, his blood paid for the NT – 1Pet 1:18-19, Heb 9:15
- f. They denied his coming – 2Pet 1:16, 3:3-4
- g. “Many shall follow” – this is prophecy such as in Mat 24:10-13
- h. These men cause evil to be spoken about the truth – Jude 4
- i. “make merchandise” – people are bought off with pleasure and ease
- j. “feigned words” = sacrament, indulgence, eucharist – 1 Cor 2:1, 2Pe 2:18

2. 2:3-9 – The Lord reserves the ungodly for judgment

- a. The judgment that lingers not, do not sleep –, Luke 12:45-46
- b. God spared not the angels – Mat 25:41, Jude 6
- c. The old world did not heed the warning for hundreds of years- Mat 24:37-39
- d. God spared not Sodom and Gomorrha – Luke 17:26-29
- e. There will be a separation of the unrighteous tares – Mat 13:36-42
- f. Lot’s deliverance was through endurance of tribulation – 2:7-8

3. 2:10-13 – The Reward of Unrighteousness

- a. “Chiefly” *def.* Primarily. (not amount or quantity, it is relevance)
- b. Lust of uncleanness and despise “authority” – just as in 1 Pet 2-19
- c. Presumption and self willed – They serve no one, Heb 13:17
- d. Korah insurrected against Moses, God consumed him - Jude 8
- e. The angels brought no accusation – Jude 9-10
- f. They spoke against what they knew not and were consumed- Num 16:12-14
- g. Brute beasts shall receive the reward of unrighteousness – 2Pet 2:12-13
- h. The reward of unrighteousness for rioting – Isa 3:11, 1 Pet 4:4-5
