

COLOSSIANS – 2:9-10

“And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:”

- Colossians 2:10

1. Col 2:9 - Fulness of the Godhead

- a. The LORD and saviour - Isa 43:10-11, 44:6
- b. A great God - Psa 86:8, 89:6, 96:4
- c. He is in a body, and will return - 1 Tim 3:16

2. 2:10 - Complete in Christ

- a. Paul's task is this verse - Col 1:28, 4:12
- b. Complete - *def.* - having no deficiency, perfect, finished, as an edifice is complete
- c. We are not complete in ourselves - Romans 12:1-2, Col 3:11
- d. We are not complete in our good works - Gal 3:3
- e. We are not complete in our abilities - 2 Cor 12:9
- f. We are not complete in spiritual gifts - 1 Cor 13:9-11
- g. The work was complete when we came unto a perfect man - Eph 4:11-14
- h. The perfect man of God is instructed by the word about Christ - 2 Tim 3:16-17
- i. To be perfect minded is to mind the high calling in Christ - Phil 3:14
- j. We are not complete in religious tradition - Col 2:8, 20, Gal 4:9
- k. There is no greater church, historical, religious authority - 2:10
