

GALATIANS 03 (1:18-2:10)

“For he that wrought effectually in Peter to the apostleship of the circumcision, the same was mighty in me toward the Gentiles:”

– Gal 2:8

1. Paul’s journeys in the beginning

Conferred not with flesh and blood – 1:16

Went into Arabia, back to Damascus (3yrs) - 1:17

Went to Jerusalem (15 days) Peter only – 1:18 [not the visit in Acts 9:26]

“I lie not” --- 1 Tim 2:7, Rom 9:1, 2 cor 11:31

2. “churches of Judea in Christ”

To be in Christ - John 6:56, John 11:26, 15:4-6

Followers of those churches in Judea – 1 thess 2:14, 1 Peter 5:14

In Christ all will be made alive - 1 Cor 15:22 –

‘preacheth the faith which he once destroyed’

Faith in Jesus as the son of God - Acts 9:20

3. “went up by revelation”

‘AND in those things which I will appear unto thee’ - Acts 26:14-16

2 Cor 12:1,7 – visions and revelations

Macedonian vision - Acts 16:9

Corinthian vision - Acts 18:9

Jerusalem vision - Acts 22:7-8

Vision in Crete - Acts 27:23-25

4. false brethren and the law

Titus was not compelled to be circumcised – Acts 15:24

Who were these false brethren? – Acts 15:1, 5 (part of the little flock)

Not the false prophets of Jude 4

Theme introduction: - liberty and bondage

5. “the same was mighty in me”

Jesus said you will do greater works - John 10:37-38,14:12

Mighty signs and wonders - Rom 15:18-20

Signs of an apostle – 2 cor 12:11.12

Gave much heed to the signs - Acts 8:6

The same that was effectual - Acts 5:12-15

The works Paul did among the Gentiles - Acts 15:12

“the grace that was given to me” – 1 cor 15:10, 2 Cor 11:5

6. “Remember the poor”

The saints at Jerusalem were the poor - Rom 15:25-26

Acts 11:29, 24:12 → because of Acts 2:44-45 and Acts 4:33-35
