1. “... But when Peter...” (2:11)

The same was mighty in me toward the Gentiles - Gal 2:7-9

2. Peter and the Law (2:12-14)

Beginning at John - Acts 1:21-22

Continuing daily in the temple – Acts 2:46-3:1

Ye are the promised covenant people - Acts 3:24-27

Peter respecting the dietary law - Acts 10:13-15

“zealous of the law” - Acts 21:18-21 - James

3. Further information and justification (2:16)

We know him by doing his commandments - 1 John 2:2

Justified by works and faith - James 2:24 -

BUT... faith without works justifies - Rom 4:5

That every mouth stop - Romans 3:19

Judged by the law – Rom 2:1 (12-18)

The same God that justifies - Rom 3:26-31

4. “Is Christ the minister sin?” (2:17-18)

Let God be true - Rom 3:3-4

“build again the things”

The body of sin is destroyed - Rom 6:6 -

The middle wall of partition - Eph 2:13-14 → which was the law of separation (Eph 2:15)

Dead to sin - Rom 6:1-3

“transgressor” – Rom 4:15, 5:13

5. Our crucifixion with Christ (2:19-20)

“dead to the law” – Rom 6:23 – 7

She is at liberty - 1 Cor 7:39

Living by grace – 2 Cor 5:14-15, 6:1

We have not received the spirit of bondage - Rom 8:13-15 – 2 Tim 1:7

Your affections – Col 3:1-3

6. “if righteousness came by the law, Christ is dead in vain!” (2:21)

He rose again for our justification – Rom 4:25

Making the preaching of Christ of none effect – 1 Cor 1:17

The righteousness by faith that Peter should’ve known - Rom 10:1-5

Perverting the gospel - Gal 1:7-8

Fallen from grace – Gal 5:4
