## Heed the Son of Man

## 1. Hebrews 2:2

- a. Chapter 1 describes the Son of God; Chapter 2 the Son of Man
- b. 1:14 "heirs of salvation" These are those who were promised it: believing Israel
- c. "therefore... give heed" to hear and obey the words the Lord more than angels
- d. "we have heard" Which puts the writer in the Lord's earthly ministry
- e. "let them slip" Only Israel could backslide how does a sinner with Rom 5:1-2?
  - i. Jer 3:6,8,11,12,14,22 see also Hosea 14:1-4 about how God will heal them
- f. "every transgression..." Backsliders are punished like Heb 10:26-31, 38-39
  - i. How shall we escape if we neglect salvation ... John 1:11

## 2. Hebrews 2:3-4

- a. Reasons this passage helps identify the author:
- b. The salvation is found in MMLJ John 4:22, Lk 1:69, 77, 2:30, 19:9
- c. Salvation then did not include the preaching of the cross! Mt 6:12, 19:17, Mk 13:13
- d. Confirmation of great salvation is confirmed by "them that heard him" in MMLJ
  - i. What is confirmed? The word Mark 16:20, the promise Rom 15:8, Lk 1:72
  - ii. The promises needed confirmed because the law was added Gal 3:17
  - iii. Jesus had the words of eternal life John 6:54, 6:6-69, 6:35/63
  - iv. The author could also be a part of "them" see John 1:11-14
- e. The witness of God in them was Pentecost Acts 2:22-33, 36
- f. Whoever this is, it is before the revelation of the mystery, before Paul
- g. Paul did not get confirmed by the twelve Gal 1:11-22, 2:1, 6-7

## 3. Hebrews 2:5-8

- a. The "world to come" is the orientation of the book of Hebrews Heb 6:5, 13:14
- b. It is the new world, the kingdom come, after the "end of the world"
- c. The twelve were promised riches and life in the world to come on earth Lk 18:30
- d. The dominion of man over the earth not angels is prophesied Ps 8:4-6
- e. "but now we see not yet" The kingdom is not yet here, but they have Jesus...
