

## John pt05 - (1:35-50)

### Manifesting the Son of God to Israel

1. John 1:35-39 – The Lamb of God declared
  - a. John's Baptism a requirement – Luke 7:26-30
  - b. Make the Messiah manifest to Israel – John 1:31 – Jesus' baptism
  - c. John's witness was needed – John 5:31-37; Mal 3:1
  - d. John declares the Lamb – 1:36
  - e. John's authority - Matt 21:23-27
  - f. John's Lamb – It is not the slaughter and sorrow of Isaiah 53:7
    - i. The Passover lamb - Exodus 12:3-5
    - ii. Two lambs a day - Exodus 29:39
    - iii. “Lamb without blemish” – Lev 4:32; Lev 22:21
    - iv. Rev 14:1 – The Lamb mentioned 29x in Rev
      1. Since the foundation of the world - Rev 13:8
      2. The Lamb: King of Kings - Rev 17:14
      3. The marriage of the Lamb – Rev 19:7-9
  - g. “taketh away the sins of the world” – 1:29
    - i. Jesus without blemish, coming from God - John 1:26-27
    - ii. Jesus' baptism – an anomaly - Matt 3:11-17 (not mentioned in John)
    - iii. Jesus has no need for a baptism for remission of sins
    - iv. Thy sins be forgiven - Mark 2:5-7
  - h. John the Baptist's testimony that Jesus is the Son of God – 1:28-34
  - i. Ignorant of the preaching of the cross (gospel of grace)
    - i. Caiaphas was ignorant - John 11:47-52
    - ii. Prophets were ignorant – 1 Peter 1:10-11
    - iii. John was ignorant – Mark 1:4; Mat 3:7
    - iv. Disciples were ignorant - Luke 18:31-34
2. John 1:40-51 – The revealing of Jesus to the apostles
  - a. Lamb of God: Declared by John – 1:29, 36
  - b. Messiah: Declared by Andrew – John 1:41 (Daniel 9:25-26)
    - i. Jesus' omniscience - Peter is a stone (not the Rock) Mat 16:18; 1 Cor 10:4
  - c. The Prophet: Declared by Philip – 1:45 (Deut 18:18) Luke 24:44
    - i. “come out of Nazareth” – Micah 5:2; John 7:41-42
  - d. King of Israel; Son of God: Declared by Nathaniel – 1:49; Jer 23:4-5
    - i. Angels ascending and descending – 1:51; Gen 28:10-16
