New Wine and Purification

1. John 2:1-11 – Marriage supper miracle
 - a. They lacked wine
 - i. Wine maketh merry – psalm 104:15
 - ii. A drought declared on new wine – Hag 1:4-11
 - b. Water was turned into wine
 - i. Not wine but the Spirit - Eph 5:18
 - ii. The wrath of God - Rev 14:8-10; 16:19
 - iii. The new wine in new wine bottles – Luke 5:36-39
 - c. It was made in purifying pots
 - i. The slovenly marriage guest - Mat 22:2-14
 - ii. The fine linen of righteousness at the marriage of the Lamb - Rev 19:7-9
 - d. It was at a marriage supper and for the governor
 - i. Beulah land and the marriage - Isa 62:1-5
 - ii. New Jerusalem as a bride - Rev 21:2,9-11
 - e. New/better wine comes at the end
 - i. The days come... a new covenant - Heb 8:8-13
 - ii. In that day... new wine - Joel 1:5,10 & 3:18
 - iii. Until I drink it new in the kingdom – Mat 26:29
 - iv. These men are full of new wine - Acts 2:13
2. John 2:12-22 – Purging out the temple
 - a. Those that sold oxen, sheep, doves – for sacrifices – Jer 7:4-11
 - b. Reason: John 2:16 - making merchandise of the law - Prov 21:3; Isa 1:11-16
 - c. 2:17 – The zeal hath eaten me up - Psalm 69:9 – Psalm 51:16-17
 - d. 2:18-22 - What sign/authority do you do these things?
 - i. Resurrection was the sign – compare John 2:19 with Rom 4:25
 - ii. 2:22 – They remembered afterwards and it gave his message credibility
 1. They knew not – John 20:8-9; Luke 24:7-9; 44
 2. By what authority? – Mat 21:23; Mk 1:22,27
 3. I am resurrection and life - John 11:25
 4. “I will raise it up” – Acts 2:24
3. John 2:23-25 – Growing fame and popularity
 - a. He grows in popularity, but everyone turns against him – Isa 53
 - b. Omniscience – John 1:42; Heb 4:13 – Why does God ask questions?
 - c. “what was in man” - Jer 17:9; “out of the heart proceedeth evil” - Mat 15:19
 - d. “needed not the testimony” – John 10:18
 - i. His works are the greater testimony – John 5:36; 9:32-33; 10:25
 - ii. The works proved he was Messiah – Luke 7:20-23; John 15:24
