

# John pt26 - (13:1-38)

## Jesus and Foot Washing

1. John 13:1-5 – The foot washing
  - a. 13:2 – The devil put into the heart of Judas – John 6:70
  - b. 13:3-5 – The following actions are done in full knowledge of who he is
2. John 13:6-11 – Peter’s disruption
  - a. 13:6-9 - Note: Peter is trying to honor him
  - b. 13:8 – “thou hast no part with me” – was he serious?! (works based)
  - c. 13:10 - “save to wash his feet” – Clean/unclean by
3. John 13:12-20 – The explanation
  - a. Foot washing in the Bible – Gen 18:4; 24:32; Exo 30:19-21; Luke 7:38-44
    - i. For priests in the temple = required
    - ii. For people = good work (1 Tim 5:10)
    - iii. It is not a rite or even about the feet – Mark 7:2-23
  - b. 13:13 – Jesus is Lord and Master puts on humility – Mat 19:30; 20:16
  - c. 13:14-15 – The example of Jesus – is it washing feet?
  - d. 13:16 – This is the theme of the next 3 chapters – John 15:20
  - e. 13:18-19 – “that ye may believe that I am he” – 13:3-5
  - f. 13:20 – “who I send, receiveth me” – John 20:21 (also – Acts 22:21)
    - i. This is exclusive of other religions.
  - g. 13:18,21 - – The betrayer identified – “hath lifted up his heel against me”
  - h. 13:22-26 – Peter is still clueless to the cross – 13:28, 38
4. John 13:31-35 – A new commandment
  - a. 13:31-32 – The glory is the “Hour” & spoken by the prophets (1 Pet 1:11)
  - b. 13:33-34 – Jesus is going away and his instructions are to love one another
    - i. The love requirement in John 14:15& 21; 15:12; 1 John 3:14; 5:2
    - ii. This is the law – Luke 10:25-28
  - c. 13:35 – Ye shall know if you are my disciples – 1 John 5:2
5. John 13:36-38 – Peter’s blind ambition
  - i. He claims to be willing to lay down his life – but he does not
  - ii. Mark 10:35-45 – Jesus came to die, and to minister unto the many
  - iii. He will come again in glory – John 13:36 → To Peter: “not yet”
    1. Acts 1:16-17 – The answer is “not for you to know”
