

John pt27 - (14:16-31)

Love, Comfort, and Peace

1. John 14:16-17 – The Spirit of Truth
 - a. Prophetically, Jesus came for Israel’s New Testament – Eze 36:26
 - b. The new spirit = The Spirit of Truth – John 15:26-27, 16:13-14
 - c. 14:26 -“He shall teach you all things”–Mat 10:19; Luke 21:14, 1 John2:20
 - i. Paul tells us to study and be taught–2 Tim 2:2,15, Titus 1:9,Col 2:7
 - d. “The promise of the Father” – Luke 24:49, Acts 1:4, 2:33
 - i. Baptism with the Holy Ghost by Jesus - Mat 3:11
 - ii. They were filled supernaturally – Acts 2:4; 4:8; 5:3
 - iii. *Different than...* baptism by HG into Christ – 1 Cor 12:13; Eph 4:4
 - iv. You must be filled – Eph 5:18
2. John 14:18-20 – “I will come again”
 - a. When is this? – The Spirit will not be given until after the resurrection.
 - b. 14:18 – The comfort and peace that he leaves (14:1)
 - c. 14:19 – The burial and resurrection
 - d. 14:20 – Being “In Christ” is necessary for every man
 - i. “In Christ” is the goal, the way is different – 1 John 4:15-16
 - ii. Being “in Christ” is conditional on obedience - John 15:5-6
 - iii. “Christ in you” – Col 1:25; this is called a mystery
 - iv. Ye are complete in Christ - Col 2:10; Gal 2:20
 - v. Beware... In Christ before Paul - Rom 16:7
3. John 14:21-24 – Love and the Commandments – “If ye love me, keep...”
 - a. 14:21 – manifest to those who do the commandments
 - b. 14:23 – The commandment to love - John 15:10-14; Mat 22:37
 - c. Love and commandment keeping are inseparable in John 14
 - d. John 15:13 – Greater love hath no man...
 - e. Paul speaks of a greater love → Rom 5:8,10
4. John 14:25-30 – Dispensational Peace
 - a. 14:25 - “while I am present with you”... and 14:29
 - b. 14:27 – “Peace I leave with you” – what is peace? (remember Luke 12:51)
 - i. The way of peace they have not known - Rom 3:17
 - ii. Luke 1:70-71; 8-79 – Guide them in the way of peace → Psalm 23
 - iii. Isaiah 32:7 – *def.* the work of righteousness shall be peace
 - iv. Isa 59:4,8 – Peace does not forsake judgment and righteousness
 - c. Jesus leaves peace through his commandments - John 16:33
 - d. Jesus revealed to Paul peace through his blood – Rom 5:1, Col 1:20
