

John pt36 - (19:23-42)

The Son of God Crucified

1. John 19:23-37 – That the scripture might be fulfilled

- a. Do not insert information into the scripture that is not there.
- b. Jesus came to fulfill prophecy - Luke 24:44-48
- c. 19:23-24 – The garments – Psalm 22:18
- d. 19:28-29 – Thirst and vinegar – Psalm 22:15; Psalm 69:21
- e. 19:30 – He gave up his life – John 10:17-18
 - i. He will raise it in three days – John 2:19-21; Mat 12:39-40
- f. 19:31-33,36 – Not a broken bone – Psalm 22:17
 - i. Death by crucifixion - Psalm 22:16; John 18:32
 - ii. The wounds in the hands – Zech 13:6
 - iii. The scattered “sheep” – Zech 13:7 & John 16:32, Mat 26:31
- g. 19:31 - Taken down before night → Deut 21:22-23; Gal 3:13
- h. 19:34, 37 – The piercing – Zech 12:10-14
 - i. Blood and water – 2 Sacraments? – No.
 - ii. Blood shed for many - Mat 26:28 → Passover meal type
 - iii. “Water doth now save us” – 1 Peter 3:21, Acts 22:16

2. The Crucifixion according to Prophecy

- a. The death was not secret – Mat 16:21 – “he began”
- b. The blame for the nation was not a secret – Isa 53:5-8; 1 Peter 1:10,11
- c. No one looked to Jesus’ cross for free justification – Acts 5:28
- d. Do we preach “remission” of sins or deliverance from it? – Rom 6:7
- e. What happens to the law? → Col 2:14
- f. The preaching of the cross is our gospel → 1 Cor 1:18
- g. It is their shame → Acts 2:23-24, Acts 3:13-14
- h. The secret is the purpose to form a new creature – Eph 2:15, Rom 4:24-25

3. John 19:38-42 – The burial

- a. Joseph and Nicodemus (secret disciples) – John 12:42; Mat 10:32-33
- b. 19:40 - Wound it in linen with the spices – Luke 24:1
- c. 19:42 – “because of the Jews preparation day” – The timing is significant
 - i. Jesus had to come and had to die at a certain time – Dan 9:26
 - ii. The Jewish timeline is being fulfilled according to its calendar of high Sabbaths:
 1. Passover, Unleavened bread, First fruits, Pentecost, Trumpets, Day of Atonement, Feast of Tabernacles
